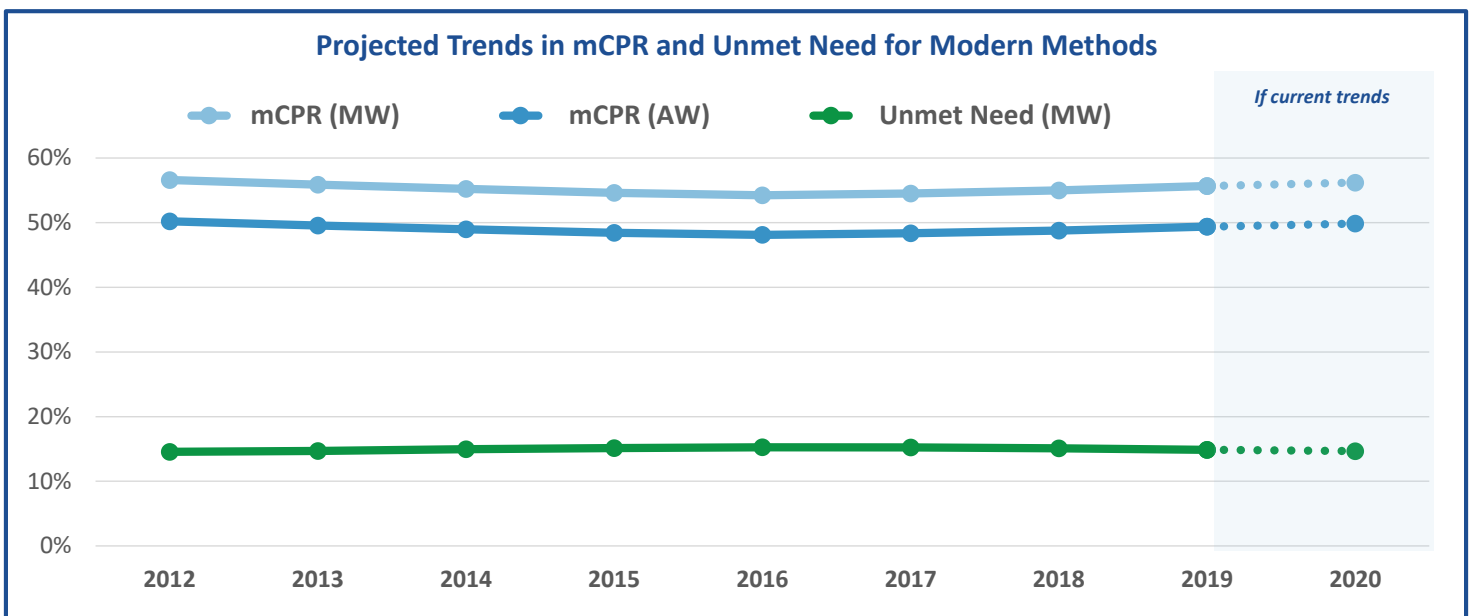

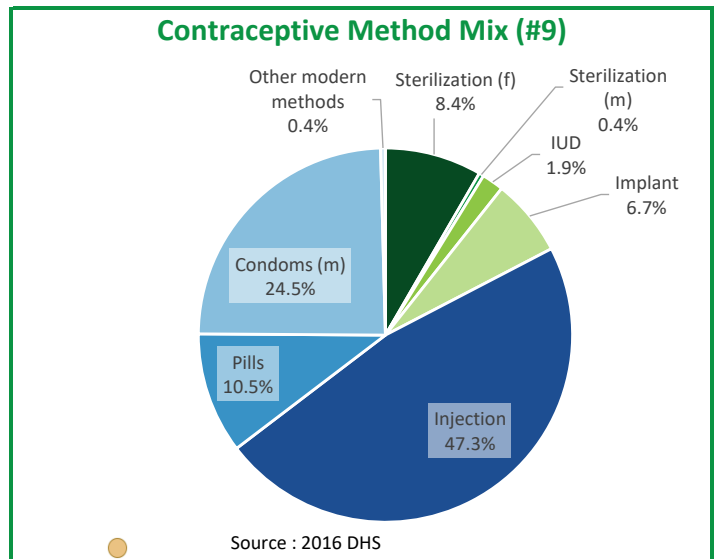


In 2019, we estimate

- 2,913,000** unintended pregnancies prevented (#6)
- 265,000** unsafe abortions averted (#7)
- 2,500** maternal deaths averted (#8)
